ABOUT KOINESÚNĒ

The Crossroad is a collection of resources that invites leaders to make choices that align with their true character and influence the world around them. Under [The Crossroad](#) brand we manage [Yellow Balloons](#), the [Servant Leadership Tools](#), and our newest addition, [Koinesúnē](#). **Koinesúnē** is a digital magazine created to serve as a hub to explore and discuss church structure and the effectiveness of The Body of Christ.

Our goal is to celebrate the pursuit of authentic discipleship, wherever it is found.

The magazine's name, Koinesúnē, is a word we created by combining the Greek words koinonia (fellowship/community) and dikaiosúnē (righteousness/harmony). The purpose of Koinesúnē is to help fan the flames of a great awakening, where Christian institutions realign with the purpose of church, the heart of The Body of Christ is elevated, more people come to faith, and the human spirit grows in service to God and one another. We hope to spend more time covering what is working than what is not working.

We are seeking reporters to pick up story pitches and write regularly for Koinesúnē's digital publication.

OPPORTUNITIES

- Paid monthly according to quantity and type of article:
 - **Long Form Articles** (2000-3000 word count): \$100/article
 - **Medium Form Articles** (750-2000 word count): \$50/article
 - **Short Form Articles** (500-750 word count): \$25/article
 - **Q & A/Interview Articles** \$20/article

REQUIREMENTS

- Can write articles as often or as little as you desire (No requirement for # of articles that must be written per month).
- Communication and collaboration with Editorial Team



- You will be writing and working remotely – we are not providing an office space for you to work in, but there will be opportunities to pick up pitches and meet with editors and reporters at regularly scheduled meetings on King’s campus.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Picking up pitches and writing articles to be submitted for [Koinesúnē’s digital publication](#).
- Familiarizing yourself with our editorial standards in order to ensure your writing aligns with the organization's mission, vision, and values.
- Working with the Editorial Team to make edits to your articles.
- Work within systems established to ensure articles are written, submitted, and edited properly.
- Meetings with Editors whenever necessary or desired.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Familiar with AP Style
- Not required, but experience working in journalism/at a magazine
- Not required, but helpful to have had published work
- Passion for journalism and a desire to grow your portfolio of published work
- Independently motivated, passion for the mission of Koinesúnē, Eagerness to learn and passion for journalism, ability to self-govern and ability to manage one’s own time, collaboration with the Editorial Team.
